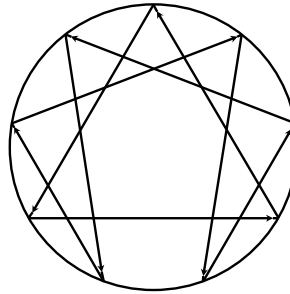

OVERVIEW

The Enneagram is a powerful and dynamic personality system that describes nine distinct and fundamentally different patterns of thinking, feeling, and acting. Each of the nine patterns is based on an explicit perceptual filter. This filter determines the focus of your attention and how you direct your energy. Underneath each of the nine patterns is a basic proposition, or belief, about what you need in life for survival and satisfaction. Each one of us developed one of the nine patterns to protect a specific aspect of our essence or essential self that felt threatened as our personality was developing.

The workshop will

1. Explore all types to enhance awareness in oneself and others.
2. Identify patterns that have fostered the suffering in our lives.
3. Take a new look at the centers of intelligence, which provides understanding of type triggers, or what frustrates, annoys or hurts each type.

- Overview of the Enneagram and of its possibilities as a tool of psychological growth
- Use of Enneagram Typing Cards
- Find own most likely type
- Psychological challenges of type
- Experience Narrative Tradition by participating on type panels
